

No Area Out of Reach with the Campey Pedestrian AeraSeeder

Campey Turf Care Systems has hard to reach areas covered for overseeding with the launch of the new Pedestrian AeraSeeder.

Smaller areas such as ornamental gardens, cemetery plots, golf greens, goalmouths, and other bare areas are easily accessible for the machine, which is only 83cm wide. It provides simple yet accurate overseeding, with a 60cm seeding area and a multi-spiked roller that produces approximately 800 perforations per square yard, effectively saturating the top surface with a network of holes.

This network, combined with the brush and smooth packing roller systems and stainless-steel seed apertures, offers the highest percentage of grass seed germination.

Lee Morgado Campey Director explains: "We're always looking at new ways to help turf professionals with issues they might have, and often trying to overseed areas where larger machines can't access is one of them. In settings like cemeteries, this is a daily issue, but we also see it in small ornamental gardens at stately homes or around racecourses.

"The AeraSeeder is perfect for those areas, but as with all of the machines we produce, we want it to be top quality, and that is why it's also suitable for working on golf greens and goalmouths. This is a powerful small machine that brings high quality overseeding to every area it can work on."
